

Summary of the Walks

with leaflet numbers

1	Mitchel Troy Loop	3.5 miles	20+ stiles	Views, farmland, woodland and country lane, one steep ascent and one steep descent
2	Wonastow Loop	2.5 miles	7 stiles	Views, farmland, one gentle ascent and descent
3	Lydart Loop	2 miles	14 stiles	Views and history, farmland, one steep ascent and one steep descent
4	Lloysey Loop	2 miles	No stiles	Woodland trim trail, fairly flat
5	Penallt Loop	10 miles	20+ stiles	One strenuous ascent and steep descent, farmland, forest and woodland, church and pub

If you walk with a dog, please be aware that there is livestock in some of the fields and dogs should therefore be on leads and kept strictly under control. Please follow the Countryside Code:

- Be safe – plan ahead and follow any signs
- Leave gates and property as you find them
- Protect plants and animals, and take your litter home
- Keep dogs under close control
- Consider other people

Some of the paths are not Public Rights of Way and are walked with the permission of the land-owner. This permission may be withdrawn at any time.

It is strongly recommended that the leaflets are used in conjunction with the Ordnance Survey Explorer Map OL14.
